Messenger, a former British military officer, and approximately 200 advisors and contributors have compiled a critical annotated bibliography of the latest scholarship on military topics. Intended for scholars, the work covers topics from ancient to modern times and attempts to be universal in coverage, although there is some Western European and North American emphasis. Topics include land, sea, and air services; conflicts; types of warfare; military theory; prominent military leaders; and national armed services. There is no coverage of hardware.

More than 500 entries are arranged alphabetically, from *Abyssinia: British and Italian expeditions, 1867-1896* to *Zhukov, Georgii*. A typical entry begins with a bibliography of monographs and articles, primarily in English. This is followed by a page or more of text discussing the cited sources. All entries are signed and include *see also* references. In the front of the book are an alphabetical list of entries; a thematic list by region, chronology, and topic; and a chronological list of individuals. Following the entries, a "Booklist Index" refers to the sources that are discussed in the entries and is organized by author. This is followed by a general index.

There are very few similar resources. *The American Historical Association's Guide to Historical Literature* (Oxford, 1995) does have annotated bibliographies to assist scholars, but military coverage is fragmented. The *Reader's Guide to Military History* is a unique, well-designed reference tool that will be useful to academic, large public, and specialized libraries. *RBB*
